9:30 am to 4:30 pm Animalia in Miniature with Ruth Vreeland

Students will learn the basics of handling watercolor paints and brushes, and explore a variety of techniques (glazing, layering, methods for saving the white of the paper, juxtapositioning of color, key techniques in creating the perfect neutral color, softening and/or losing a few edges).

Painting subjects will be mostly Zoo animals, using Ruth's reference photos. Students may also bring in a reference photo of their own to use, if the lighting provides good contrast and the photo has clear detail. We will also briefly explore the fundamentals of composition, contrast of values, the essentials of a good initial drawing, how to achieve perfect *chiaroscuro* and working from great vs. bad photo references.

Thursday, April 4, 2019

Learn Ukrainian batik style egg art. Pysanka means to write on egg shell. In this class you will learn the basics of layering hot beeswax and aniline dye to create your own Pysanka. You will take home 2 – 3 Pysanky, as time and ability allows. We will be working with empty chicken egg shells but you will learn how to empty whole eggs. History, tradition, symbolism, color meanings, kistky types (hot wax pen), wax types, writing on different egg shells and more will be covered.

The artist will have supplies for purchase if you wish to continue doing pysanka after the workshop.

Friday, April 5, 2019

9:30 am to 4:30 pm Become a Skywatcher with Katherine Irish

This pastel workshop will have you approaching skies in exhilarating colors with personality. Big skies over the desert, approaching weather, defined by the size and shapes of clouds.
